

"I am the Bread of Life, he who comes to me shall not hunger."

Notes from last Sunday's sermon series:

-All creatures hunger for something...while man hungers for food he has a hunger for something deeper.

-The world convinces people that they need the things of this world to satisfy their deeper hunger: money, a career, success, prestige, a relationship...

-God has made us to have a relationship with Him and nothing but that will satisfy our inner hunger.

-Young people often wander away from the Faith because they "buy" the lie: things of this world will bring happiness, fulfillment and satisfaction.

-These things do bring happiness, fulfillment and satisfaction but only for a time.

-Jesus said if we come to Him, He will bring us complete and lasting happiness, fulfillment, satisfaction.

- While the other "*I am*" statements of Jesus use symbols like: *I am the Door...I am the Good Shepherd...* Jesus statement "*I am the Bread of Life*" is not just a symbolic statement but a reality.

-Through the bread and wine of the Holy Eucharist we receive Him who is the "Bread of Life".
